We are always seeking donations of new and used items in good, saleable condition. We accept furniture, appliances, household items, cabinets, building materials and other items.

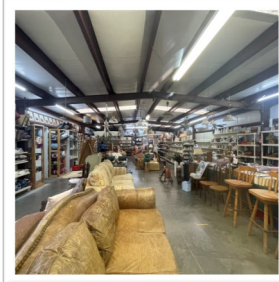

The ReStore Re-Boot

This Spring, the Chowan-Perquimans Habitat for Humanity (CPH4H) ReStore closed its doors for one week. Volunteers and CPH4H board members worked tirelessly throughout the week and beyond to give the ReStore a much-needed facelift.



Volunteers sorted through inventory and cleaned or discarded items that were no longer in good condition. They cleaned and repaired the facility and built new shelving and display tables. Old storage units were discarded and two new out-buildings were built to hold large furniture items and outdoor goods. The volunteers meticulously organized the inventory and restocked shelves in clearly-defined sections to help customers locate items much easier. The ReStore also purchased and branded a new truck for pick-up and delivery of large donations to the store.

“The truck has been a great asset for bringing-in quality donations that have led to record sales figures. It should serve well as a rolling billboard moving forward,” said Mike Finamore, CPH4H Board President. “Thanks to Mike Rammel for his efforts in bringing this project to completion.”

The ReStore is now back up-and-running, providing the community with a wide-ranging inventory of second-hand home goods, books, toys, sporting goods, furniture and much, much more. Mary Griffith, a veteran volunteer for 13 years, commented that the changes have made a positive impact on the staff and the customers at the restore. We’ve received numerous positive comments from our regular customers.

Proceeds from the ReStore help to fund building projects for CPH4H, an all-volunteer, non-denominational Christian housing ministry that has been providing affordable housing to our local community for twenty-six years. The ReStore is open year-round, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays from 9am to 1pm.

Inventory at the ReStore comes solely from local donations. If you have household goods that you would like to donate, please bring them to the ReStore during business hours or call 252-482-2686 to request large item pick-up.
